

MULTI-CREW COORDINATION COURSE - HELICOPTER



PRIVILEGES

With the MCC course you will be able to operate on multi-crew helicopters. The commander must have an ATPL license, whereas the co-pilot must hold a CPL license, must have passed the ATPL theory exam and must have attended and passed an MCC course.



PRE-REQUISITES

The MCC certificate can be obtained by professional pilots who already hold a CPL license or by the pilots who are attending an integrated ATPL course.



THEORETICAL COURSE

The theoretical course is organized by Italfly Academy for a minimum of 4 students. It lasts 25 hours and the student is expected to pass an internal exam at the end of the course.



PRACTICAL COURSE

All the flight activity is carried out in the FNTP II flight simulator and consists in 20 hours for the MCC IFR certificate and 15 hours for the MCC VFR only. The simulator is in Trento Italfly Academy homebase.

Students who attend an ATP integrated course (both VFR and IFR) have a dispensation of 5 hours in the flight simulator.

For obvious reasons it is necessary to have two students for this course. In case there will be only one student, Italfly Academy will provide the services of a certified pilot who takes the part of the CM2. In this case all the flight hours (15 for VFR and 20 for IFR) will be charged to the applicant.

The prices listed below, refer to every single student who does come with a "partner" pilot for the CM2 part.
